Please email jdacostaartdesign@gmail.com a high quality, up close photo of your pet. I will use this photo to make your painting. Therefore it is very important to follow the below guidelines to ensure your artwork comes out looking the best it can be!

- Should be in focus, I can't use blurry images.
- Good lighting is important, preferably use natural lighting, or a well lit room, if the photo is too dark we won't be able to capture your pets features on the art work.
- The photo should be taken at eye level with your pet. Forward facing you. Think cute and cuddly. They don't need to be looking at the camera, just off center works really well.
- Take an up close picture to capture as much detail as you can.
- Make sure I can see all your pets head in the photo, if part of the pet is not there I won't be able to use.
- Don't forget to upload up at least **three** photos and I can choose the best one!
